OSHA 10-HOUR COURSE:

Overview

This training program is intended to provide excavating contractors information about their rights, employer responsibilities, and how to file a complaint, as well as how to identify, abate, avoid and prevent job related hazards on a construction site. The training covers a variety of construction safety and health hazards which a worker may encounter at a construction site. Training will emphasize hazard identification, avoidance, control, and prevention.

OSHA Focus Four Hazards

Covering the topics of fall hazards, electrocution, Struck-By (e.g. falling objects, trucks, cranes), and Caught-In or Between (e.g. trench hazards, equipment)

Personal Protective and Lifesaving Equipment

Identify the need and proper use of personal protection equipment.

Health Hazards in Construction

Noise, crystalline silica, hazard communication.

Additional Safety Topics

Rules associated with digging, including soil types and benching/sloping practices; who is a competent person and what a competent person needs to know, as well as other OSHA rules and regulations addressing jobsite issues.

REGISTRATION INCLUDES:

Attendees will receive a copy of OSHA's Construction Industry Digest (OSHA Form 2202-09R 2015), an OSHA certification card, a certificate of completion, one lunch, and DHSS CEUs.

1ST AID/CPR/AED:

This American Safety & Health Institute (ASHI) program helps participants recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing, and first aid emergencies. The course will teach the knowledge and skills needed to give immediate care to an injured or ill person and to decide whether advanced medical care is needed.

The program conforms to the 2015 AHA Guidelines Update for CPR and ECC, and the 2015 AHA and ARC Guidelines

Update for First Aid, and will be taught by David Miguel, owner of Underground Safety & Supply, LLC and certified ASHI instructor.

REGISTRATION INCLUDES:

A two-year certification through ASHI, a certificate of completion, and DHSS CEUs. The full 1st Aid/CPR/AED certification course includes lunch.
