On January 5, the Missouri Land Improvement Contractors Association (LICA) will host a special "Contractor and Employee Boot Camp" designed to help you meet your OSHA training needs.

OSHA Fork Lift Certification

Did you know that in order to operate a "fork lift," OSHA requires you to have a certification ... and that OSHA defines a skid steer with forks as a "fork lift?" This class will give you the three-year certification you need.

CPR and AED Training

Although OSHA does not specifically require CPR training, the OSHA requirement at 29 CFR 1910.151(b) states, "In the absence of an infirmary, clinic, or hospital in near proximity to the workplace which is used for the treatment of all injured employees, a person or persons shall be adequately trained to render first aid." Are your employees trained? Are you? Can anyone on your crew operate an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)? This class will give you the two-year certification you need for CPR, a resource manual for your CPR and first-aid needs, as well as the basics of operating an Automated External Defibrillator.

Overhead Powerline Safety

When was the last time you held a discussion with your employees or reminded yourself of the dangers associated with contacting these lines? How much current do they carry? How can you tell? This class will offer a live demonstration of the dangers of overhead powerline contact, as well as educate you on what you can do to prevent them.

What To Do When OSHA Arrives

What should you or your employees do when OSHA arrives on the jobsite? Can you restrict OSHA's access to your jobsite? What are your rights? How can you minimize your fines? This class will teach you and your employees what you can do ... and what you don't want to do ... when OSHA arrives on your jobsite. According to our OSHA experts, it's not a question of "if" OSHA will arrive on your jobsite in the next three to five years, but "when." Will you be ready?
